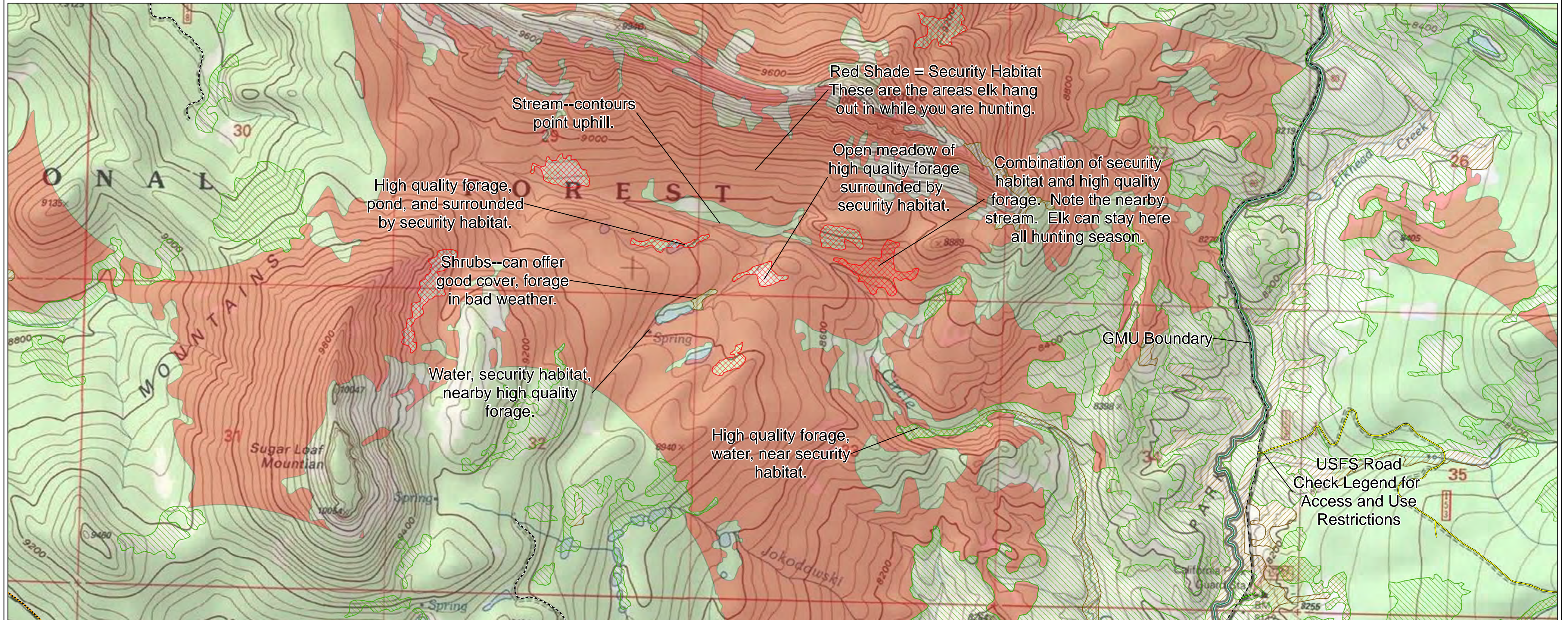


# ELKTRACKER™ MAPS--NOW YOU HAVE THE ADVANTAGE

The difference between ElkTracker Maps and all other maps that are available is that they show you exactly where you need to be hunting by identifying the three things elk need to survive--Cover, Forage, and Water. **We have spent the last year compiling data from Colorado Parks and Wildlife, the U.S. Forest Service, BLM, USGS, and many other agencies to figure out where these areas exist on a statewide scale.** What we have come up with are two features unique to the ElkTracker Maps--Security Habitat and Prime Forage areas. By combining security habitat and prime forage areas with elk ranges and land ownership information, you will be able to identify the areas where elk are likely to congregate when feeling pressured during the hunting seasons.

Security habitat can be defined as the areas elk seek out when they are feeling pressured, and are a combination of heavy canopy cover, are located an adequate distance from motorized roads, and are large enough to provide escape routes. Prime forage areas are places that offer above average grazing opportunities for elk and consist of high quality grasses and forbs. The combination of these two features on one map allows you to identify the "Hot Spots" in the area you are hunting and should increase your chances for a successful hunt.
